Please share the following information with your parents and campers.

Camper Check-in Process: Check in on Sunday, **July 28th (Camp 1)**, **Sunday, Aug 2 (Camp 2)** beginning at 10:00 A.M. at **Brightmoor Aldersgate UMC, located at 12065 W. Outer Drive** (at Acacia St., South of 5 Mile, North of I-96) Detroit, MI 48223. After Check-In, we will join Pastor Jonathan (Camp Pastor) in the sanctuary for a short Camp Service and send-off.

Please follow the entire Check-In process:

1. Keep luggage in your car until you have reached **Station 4**.
2. Stations will be marked as follows:

Station 1: Camper Registration, Release Form, Cabin Assignment, Bus Assignment (All forms must be completed and signed, all monies collected, camper receives lanyard.)

Station 2: Nurse (Bring all medications in the original containers. All meds must be turned in at this time and will be released by the camp nurse. Check with the nurse about inhalers. Nurse will check health form).

Station 3: Luggage Tag and Lunch Tickets (Campers will be given luggage tags and lunch tickets.)

Please limit luggage to two items, a clothing bag and a bedding bag. Label the inside of clothing and other items.

Station 4: Luggage Area (Retrieve luggage from your car and attach the luggage tag. Place luggage in the designated area: Bus #1- Red Bus Luggage Area or Bus #2- Blue Bus Luggage Area.)

3. After Check-in, campers and parents will quietly enter Camp Worship Service prepared specifically for all Camp 2019 participants.
4. A bag lunch will be served to those who have tickets (those who have completed the entire registration process) at around 12:30 P.M..
5. The bus will depart at around 1:30 P.M. for Judson Collins Camp Center, Onsted, MI.

Camper Check-Out Process:

1. Campers will return to Brightmoor around 4 P.M. **Friday, Aug 2th (Camp 1)** & **Friday, Aug 9 (Camp 2)**
2. Please be on time to pick up your camper.
3. Bring your I.D. You must sign-out your camper before leaving. **(ONLY THE PERSON ON THE RELEASE FORM CAN SIGN OUT YOUR CHILD.)**
